As International Director for the Americas, my role is to give leadership and pastoral care to our missionaries as we seek to fulfill our mission of making disciples among all the nations of the Americas. We are working together to see Christ's Church established and strengthened so that the gospel of his kingdom will advance through all the world. Please pray for me in this mission!

Some practical prayer needs:

More missionaries: Jesus told us to pray to the Lord of the harvest that he would raise up more workers. We look around us and see so many opportunities for fruitful ministry - but the workers are few. Please pray that the Lord would add to our number.

Housing: It seems like a broken record at this point: the owner of our house canceled the renewal of our contract. He's open to a new one, but it seems that he's looking to make up for the devaluation that the Colombian peso has been going through. Please pray for us to have wisdom regarding either negotiating a new lease or looking for a new place. Moving is never convenient - and we'd like to be in a place where we didn't have an annual period of uncertainty regarding our home.

Wisdom about opportunities: Pray for us to have wisdom as we choose what to say 'yes' to. We have many options for local ministry involvement, but we need to say 'yes' to the things that are really from the Lord. Pray that we would have his guidance.
